Rides are provided through both our Road to Recovery Program and our Transportation Grants provided to St. Peter's Health System & Albany Med Health System.



89 Capital Region residents stayed at an ACS Hope Lodge.

Those 89 residents spent **1,898 nights**

completely free allowing them to travel for the best cancer treatment for them without having to find a place to stay or a way to pay.

HopeClub offers a variety of emotional and support services for cancer patients and their families such as support groups, weekly community lunches, wellness programs and more!



\$35,000 Invested

ACS provided a lodging grant to Albany Med Health System to provide hotel lodging for patients who need a place to stay when receiving treatment.



\$783,000 research grant

We funded a 3 year research grant awarded to Dr. Jeremy Logue, Ph. D. of Albany Med.

Dr. Logue is studying the way cancer cells migrate which is allowing us to learn how to stop cancer.



\$40,000 Quality Improvement

Grants provided to increase the access and affordability of breast cancer screenings at both Saratoga Hospital and St. Peter's Health System
